

PM ANNOUNCES 20 LAKH CR ECONOMIC PACKAGE & CALLS FOR ATMANIRBHAR BHARAT

- He said that the package will provide a much needed boost towards achieving 'Atmanirbhar Bharat'.
- He exhorted people to work towards their targets while taking precautions like wearing masks and maintaining 'do gaz doori'.


Economic package a commendable step to make country Self-Reliant: JP Nadda

CAPF CANTEENS WILL SELL ONLY INDIGENOUS PRODUCTS FROM JUNE 01: Amit Shah



PM Shri Narendra Modi made an appeal on 12 May to make the country self-reliant and use products made in India. Union Home Minister Shri Amit Shah has described this appeal as a guiding light to make India the Global Leader in future.

- In this direction on 13 May, the Ministry of Home Affairs has decided that all the Central Armed Police Forces (CAPF) canteens and stores across the country will now sell only indigenous products, from June 01, 2020.
- The total purchase value would be around Rs. 2800 crore. With this decision, 50 lakh family members of about 10 lakh CAPF personnel will use indigenous products.
- The Home Minister also appealed to the people of the country and said, "You should use the products made in the country as much as possible and encourage others to do the same. This is not the time to be lagging behind, but to turn the crisis into an opportunity."

MEASURES ANNOUNCED BY FINANCE MINISTER FOR 'AATMANIRBHAR BHARAT'

Union Finance Minister Smt. Nirmala Sitharaman in a press conference on 13 May said the package announced by PM Shri Narendra Modi on 12 May, 2020 is to spur the growth and make India self-reliant. That is why it is called 'Aatmanirbhar package'.

- The FM said to provide stressed MSMEs with equity support, Govt will facilitate Rs. 20,000 crore as subordinate debt. Two lakh MSMEs are likely to benefit.
- Rs. 3 lakh crore Collateral-free Automatic Loans for Businesses, including MSMEs.
- Global tenders to be disallowed in Government procurement up to Rs. 200 crore.
- E-market linkage for MSMEs to be promoted to act as a replacement for trade fairs and exhibitions.
- Govt decides to continue EPF Support for Business and Workers for 3 more months providing a relief of Rs 2,500 crore to 3.67 lakh establishments and for 72.22 lakh employees.
- Government launches a Rs. 30,000 crore Special Liquidity Scheme for NBFCs/HFCs/MFIs.
- In a major relief to contractors, all Central agencies to provide an extension of up to 6 months, without cost to contractor.

542 'Shramik Special' trains ferried 6.48 lakh migrants



The railways has operated 542 'Shramik Special' trains since 01 May and ferried home 6.48 lakh migrants stranded in various parts of the country amid the Coronavirus-induced lockdown.

- A statement issued by the Union Ministry of Home Affairs said the railways will now run 100 'Shramik Special' trains on a daily basis to facilitate a faster movement of workers.
- The trains have ferried migrants to cities such as Tiruchirappalli, Titlagarh, Barauni, Khandwa, Jagannathpur (Brahmapur), Khurda Road, Prayagraj, Chhapra, Balia, Gaya, Purnia, Varanasi, Darbhanga, Gorakhpur, Lucknow, Jaunpur, Hatia, Basti, Katihar, Danapur, Muzzaffarpur, Saharsa etc.
- During the journey, the passengers are given free meals and water.
- From 11 May, these 'Shramik Special' trains started carrying around 1,700 passengers each, instead of the earlier 1,200, to ferry as many workers home as possible.

FCI distributes about 160 LMT food grains during lock down

Food Corporation of India is ensuring uninterrupted supply of wheat and rice throughout the country during the lock down period. Government/FCI has not only met the foodgrain requirement under National Food Security Act @ 5 KG/ Month/Beneficiary but also the additional allocation of 5Kg/Person to 81.35 Crore people under PM Garib Kalyan Ann Yojana.

Coronavirus cases doubling time slows down to 12.2 days from 10.9

Even as the number of Covid-19 cases continues to increase, the doubling time has slowed to 12.2 days over the last three days from 10.9 days in the past 14 days, Health Minister Dr. Harsh Vardhan said on 12 May, highlighting the need for enhanced surveillance and contact tracing in view of migrants and expats returning home.

- Out of 70,756 cases, 22,455 people have been cured and 2,293 have died.
- He said the fatality rate was 3.2% while the recovery rate was progressively increasing and stood at 31.74%.
- Reviewing measures for management of Covid-19 cases in Jammu & Kashmir, Ladakh, Uttarakhand and Himachal Pradesh Dr. Vardhan asked states and UTs to focus more on surveillance, testing, contact tracing and timely treatment of all returnees.
- He suggested that the Aarogya Setu app be made compulsory for all returnees for better surveillance and suitable medical interventions.
