- ❖ Strong action against terrorists in last 5 years
- ❖ Forty years old demand of 'One Rank One Pension' fulfilled

INTERNAL SECURITY : DEVELOPMENT IN NAXAL-AFFECTED AREAS

- ❖ In the 34 Maoist-hit districts of the country, Construction of 4,500 km roads completed
- ❖ 44 districts were removed from the list of 126 districts affected by leftist terrorism
- ❖ 20% decline in Naxalite incidents in affected states
- ❖ Establishment of 2,400 mobile towers, 4,072 additional towers to improve communication system in Naxal affected areas
- ❖ Between April 2015 and December 2017, 430 new bank branches and 1,045 ATMs were established in 35 districts of Naxal-affected districts.
- ❖ Between 2014 to 2017, around 3,380 Naxals surrendered.

CURB ON FOREIGN FUNDING OF NGOs

- ❖ Over the last 4 years, foreign fundings of NGOs involved in unlawful activities such as opposition to development projects, inspiring political movements, activities such as conversion, are being curbed.
- ❖ Registration of 13 thousand NGOs has been cancelled from 2014-15, apart from this, decrease of 40% in FCRA license holder NGOs.
- ❖ The foreign funding received by NGOs has come down from Rs 17,799 crore in 2015-16 to Rs 15,329 crore in 2016-17.
- ❖ Building an online analytical tool to monitor overseas funding of NGOs by the Home Ministry started. This online tool will help in data-driven and evidence-based decision making.
- ❖ Anti-national activities of NGOs are being closely monitored by the state police and central agencies.
- ❖ In 2017, the Supreme Court ordered the Government of India to make strict guidelines for audit and transparency with the efforts of the Government of India in case of foreign funding in NGOs.

- ❖ Decision to celebrate June 21 as International Yoga Day on India's proposal
- ❖ Launch of yoga programs in over 90 countries of the world
- ❖ UNESCO has recognized Kumbh Mela as the Cultural Heritage (Intangible Cultural Heritage of Humanity)
- ❖ **HRIDAY and PRASHAD scheme:** Efforts being made under these schemes to restore the heritage towns
 - **HRIDAY** – (Heritage City Development & Augmentation):
 - 12 cities; 70 projects; Rs. 413 crores budget; 71% of projects completed
 - Amravati, Ajmer, Amritsar, Badami, Dwarka, Gaya, Kanchipuram, Mathura, Puri, Varanasi, Velankanni and Warangal
 - **PRASHAD**-(Pilgrimage Rejuvenation and Spiritual, Heritage Augmentation Drive and Swadesh Darshan)
 - Development work in 41 religious sites at a budget of Rs. 727 crores

- ❖ Efforts being made by Ministry of Culture to construct Shri Ram Museum in Ayodhya
- ❖ Diwali celebration in Ayodhya
- ❖ Bringing back the ancient glory of Ayodhya: In the presence of South Korea's first lady, organized the Virat Deepawali festival on the Sarayu coast
- ❖ To motivate the country with the ideals of Lord Ram: Decision to construct of 221 meter high statue of Lord Shri Ram on the bank of Sarayu in Ayodhya
- ❖ In order to make the youth aware of the life of Lord Shri Ram, the BJP Government of Uttar Pradesh is constructing a huge Ramayana Museum in 25 acres in Ayodhya at a cost of Rs. 225 crores.
- ❖ Divya Kumbh & Bhavya Kumbh: Allocation of Rs. 4200 crores budget in 2019 compared to 1300 crores in 2013, which is the largest amount sanctioned for any Kumbh celebration till date. Railways are running 800 special trains for Kumbh.
- ❖ To bring back the lost identity of Hindu culture: The city Allahabad is being renamed to its real name Prayagraj by the BJP government in Uttar Pradesh and Faizabad is being renamed as Ayodhya.
- ❖ To completely eliminate the conversion of Hindus: The BJP has proposed the anti-conversion law and has urged other parties to support it.
- ❖ **Enemy's Property Act enacted**

- ❖ The Modi government has initiated the task of giving citizenship of India to Hindu and Sikh refugees of Pakistan and Bangladesh.
- ❖ Langar and Prasad now excluded from GST
- ❖ Aviral Ganga and Nirmal Ganga: We have renewed the agreement held in the year 1916 between Mahamana and the British Government by giving an affidavit in Supreme Court to maintain the unrestricted flow of Ganga.
- ❖ With Rs. 27,000 crore budgets, the work begun under Namami Ganga Yojana.

EK BHARAT SHRESHTH BHARAT

- ❖ National Unity Day: Sardar Vallabh Bhai Patel Jayanti on 31 October 2015 is being declared as National Unity Day
- ❖ Agreement between two states per year to exchange of mutual culture, language, history, arts, sports, and knowledge
- ❖ Promotion of Indian languages: World Sanskrit Conference and World Hindi Conference held
- ❖ Mostly addressed meetings in national language during the foreign trips
- ❖ Swadeshi Darshan Yojana – Construction of Special tourist circuit: Ram circuit, Krishna circuit, Buddha circuit etc.
 - A total of 75 projects of Rs. 6100 crores have been sanctioned
- ❖ Operation of special trains for pilgrimages
- ❖ To simplify the pilgrimages for the devotees of Shri Ram a special train called Shri Ramayana Express has been started which will travel all the important places connected to Lord Rama in 16 days.
- ❖ Railway's gift to the devotees of Mata Vaishno Devi: A direct train from Jammu to Ghazipur has been started
- ❖ To simplify the Chardham yatra: Rs. 11,700 crores have been approved for connecting four Dhams through Char Dham Highway Development Project.
- ❖ Direct bus service was started for Ayodhya, the city of Lord Shri Ram from Janakpur (Nepal, the birthplace of Devi Sita).

FOREIGN POLICY

CIVILIZATION ORIENTED FOREIGN POLICY

- ❖ The Tradition of offering **Shrimad Bhagwat Gita** during the meeting with foreign nationals has been started
- ❖ The tradition of **Ganga Aarti and temple visit** has been started with the foreign leaders
- ❖ 500 quintals of sandalwood is being sent to Pashupatinath Temple for the worship
- ❖ Agreement with China to build road for Kailash Mansarovar Yatra
- ❖ Foundation stone has been laid to **construct temple in UAE, USA:** On the request of Prime Minister Shri Narendra Modi, the UAE government approved the first temple construction in Abu Dhabi.
- ❖ Culture and Civilization: Buddhist Diplomacy; Vasudhaiva Kutumbakam, Vishwaguru's goal
- ❖ Nathu-La's path was opened for the pilgrims to visit Kailash Mansarovar. This decision was taken during Prime Minister's visit to China in 2015.
- ❖ Agreement with Japan, Israel, Australia and European countries for the purification of Ganga under **Namami Gange Abhiyan**
- ❖ **Kartarpur Corridor: Dera Baba Nanak in Gurdaspur district approves the construction and development of Kartarpur corridor along the International Border**

GAU SEVA

- ❖ National Gokul Mission: A sum of Rs 546.15 crores has been released for conservation and promotion of indigenous breeds.
- ❖ Project started to construct two new National Kamdhenu Reproductive

- Centers, 20 Gokul Village, National Genomic Center and a new state-of-the-art Guided Weights Center
- ❖ Gokul Ratan and Kamdhenu award to promote indigenous breeds of cow
- ❖ Encouragement is given to e-livestock market to increase breeders and farmers of native Bovine breeds
- ❖ Crackdown on Cow-trafficking: 75% reduction in trafficking due to strict surveillance on Bangladesh border
- ❖ Establishment of the **National Kamdhenu Commission** in 2019 Budget: Under this scheme in the country, attention will be given to increase the number of cows, conservation, protection and enhancement. This includes the protection of indigenous cows.
- ❖ Security given to separatists have been withdrawn

TOWARDS THE COMMON CIVIL CODE

- ❖ With government initiatives the Supreme Court has banned social evil like Triple Talaq
- ❖ Government passed the Muslim Woman Marital Rights Security Bill in Lok Sabha and it is pending in Rajya Sabha
- ❖ Haj subsidy was completely abolished
- ❖ An affidavit was filed by the Center in the Supreme Court to put Aligarh Muslim University out of the list of minority educational institutions and put it on the list of National University.

JAMMU KASHMIR

- ❖ A meaningful attempt was made to remove the ignorance of Jammu-Ladakh region; construction of AIIMS, IIM, 5 medical colleges in Jammu has been approved and Jammu is being declared as smart city
- ❖ Special economic assistance to refugees from Pakistan Occupied Kashmir and Western Pakistan and construction of bunkers started to protect the residents of border areas.
- ❖ Several infrastructure projects were started; the implementation expedited
- ❖ Panchayat elections held successfully

HONOURING TO THE GREAT MEN

- ❖ Commemorated the birth centenary year celebration of Pandit Deendayal Upadhyaya
- ❖ The name of Mughalsarai railway junction was changed to Pandit Deendayal Upadhyaya Junction. Farah Station, located in Mathura, the birthplace of Deendayal ji, was renamed to Deendayal Dham Station.
- ❖ Bharat Ratna Award: Pandit Madan Mohan Malaviya, Nanaji Deshmukh, Atal Bihar Vajpayee were awarded
- ❖ Special session of Parliament was called on 125th anniversary of Dr. Ambedkar; Development of Panch Tirtha
- ❖ Construction of Chhatrapati Shivaji Maharaj Memorial in the Arabian Sea
- ❖ Construction of Sardar Vallabhbhai Patel's Statue of Unity
- ❖ Mahatma Gandhi: 150th Birth Anniversary (2019) Celebration
- ❖ Aurangzeb Road was renamed as APJ Abdul Kalam Marg
- ❖ Construction of National Memorial as tribute to freedom fighters
