Now, for the first time in our lives, we are witnessing eradication of poverty on a massive scale.

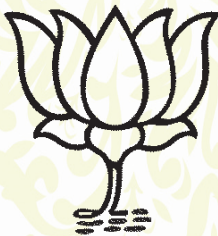
According to NITI Aayog, in the last one decade of my Government, about 25 crore countrymen have been lifted out of poverty. This is something that instills great confidence among the poor.

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## FOREWORD

The Hon'ble President of India, Smt. Droupadi Murmu delivered her first address in the new Parliament building at the beginning of the Budget session of Parliament on 31st January 2024. At the outset, she appreciated the magnificence of the new Parliament which is a testimony to India's culture & civilization and highlighted the massive success of welfare schemes of the Modi government which have drastically changed the life of the common people in the country.

Replying to the Motion of Thanks on the President's Address in Lok Sabha on 05 February 2024 and in Rajya Sabha on 7 February 2024, Prime Minister Shri Narendra Modi said the President's address is a huge document based on facts that gave an indication of the speed and scale of India's progress and also drew attention to the fact that the nation will become developed faster only if the four pillars of Nari Shakti, Yuva Shakti, the poor and the Annadata are developed and strengthened. He rightly said the address illuminates the path for the nation to become 'Viksit Bharat' by strengthening these four pillars. In his reply, the Prime Minister urged the Members to come forward shoulder to shoulder for the development of the nation. He said, "I ask for your support in the development of 'Maa Bharti' and its 140 crore citizens".

From welfare schemes to cultural rejuvenation and internal security to a robust economy, India has experienced an unparalleled transformation in the last 10 years and the position of the nation has remarkably enhanced at the comity of nations.

While opening the doors of new opportunities for the people, the Modi Government today is fulfilling its aspirations by creating an atmosphere of immense possibilities. Hills Liberation Front, etc. During this period, it took the historic decision of abrogation of Article 370, the Jammu and Kashmir Reorganization Amendment Bill, 2023, and the Jammu and Kashmir Reservation Amendment Bill, 2023, among others. This Government has made many such epoch-making decisions during the past 10 years which have been recorded in history in golden words.

Owing to all of these ground-breaking achievements, today, Shri Narendra Modi is the most popular leader in the world. He has led to a long-term vision for the country with many measures that are propelling India to the forefront globally. In this scenario, there is not even an iota of doubt, that the third term of the Modi government will witness monumental decisions. The Prime Minister rightly said, "I want to see the country prospering and reaching the pinnacle of success for the next thousand years. The third term will be dedicated to laying a strong foundation for the 1,000 years".

### 'President's address indicates the speed and scale of India's progress'

The Prime Minister, Shri Narendra Modi replied to the motion of thanks on the President's Address to Parliament in the Lok Sabha on 05 February, 2024. Shri Modi underlined that this legacy increases the dignity of the house manifold and said the 75th Republic Day, the new Parliament House, and the arrival of the 'Sengol' was a very impactful event. He thanked the Members of the House for contributing their thoughts and ideas to the Motion of Thanks on the President's Address.

Following is the full text of the PM's reply :

**H**on'ble Mr Speaker Sir, I stand here in support of the Motion of Thanks on the President's Address. When the Hon'ble President addressed all of us in this new building of the Parliament, and the way Sengol was leading the entire procession with dignity and respect, we all were following behind it ... When this new tradition in the new House becomes a reflection of that sacred moment of Bharat's independence, the dignity of democracy goes up manifold. The 75th Republic Day followed by the new parliament building and led by the Sengol ... the entire scene was very impressive. When I was participating in the entire program from there, we don't see that grandeur from here, but when I saw the President and the Vice President with their dignified presence in the new House from there ... I will always cherish that moment which was very impressive. I express my gratitude to more than 60 Hon'ble members for expressing their thoughts on the Motion of Thanks on the President's



Address with humility.

I especially commend the resolution taken by the Opposition. Each and every aspect of their speech has strengthened my and the nation's conviction that they have resolved to stay there (in the opposition benches) for a long time. You sat here (in the treasury benches) for many decades, but now you have resolved to sit there (in the opposition benches) for many more decades. And the people are like the form of God. The way you all are working hard these days, I firmly believe that the divine form of people will surely bless you. And you will definitely reach even higher heights than you are right now and will be seen in the Visitors' Gallery after the next elections. Adhir Ranjan (Chowdhury) ji, have you awarded them the contract

this time? You have facilitated these things.

I can see that many of you have also lost the nerve to fight the elections. Many people changed their seats (to contest elections) last time, and I have heard that this time

too they are eager to change their seats. And I have heard that many people now want to go to the Rajya Sabha instead of the Lok Sabha. They are trying to find their own way of assessing the situation.

### **'Nari Shakti'-'Yuva Shakti'**

The President's Address is, in a way, a document based on facts and realities, which the President has presented before the nation. And if you look at this entire document, the Hon'ble President has attempted to encapsulate the realities, which depict the pace at which the country is progressing and the scale of expansion of activities. While keeping in mind Bharat's bright future, the Hon'ble President has drawn our attention to four strong pillars. Her precise assessment is that the stronger and more developed these four pillars of the country are, the more prosperous our country will be, and it will progress rapidly. While mentioning these four pillars, she discussed the country's 'Nari Shakti' (women power), the country's 'Yuva Shakti' (youth power), our poor brothers and sisters, and the country's farmers, fishermen and our livestock breeders. The Hon'ble

President has clearly stated the direction to achieve the goals of a 'Viksit Bharat' (developed India) through the empowerment of these four pillars. You may not consider the fishermen, livestock breeders, farmers, women and the youth as minorities ... What has happened to you Dada (Adhir Ranjan Chowdhury)? Is this what you talk about the youth of this country? All sections of society are not equal. Is this what you should talk about the women of the country that they are not equal? How long will you keep thinking about divisions, how long will you keep dividing society? Limit your words, limit your boundaries, you have fragmented the country too much.

It would have been good if there were at least some positive aspects in this discussion before they make their way out. It would have been good if some positive suggestions would come up, but as always, all of you have disappointed the country a lot. The country understands the limit of your thinking. It repeatedly hurts to see this situation that this is their condition and the limit of their thinking.

The leaders may have changed, but the tape recorder is still playing the same tune.

The same old themes, nothing new comes up. The same old rhetoric and the same old tune continue from your side. It is the election year. You could have worked a bit harder, brought forward some new issues, and conveyed a message to the public, but even in that, you failed. Ok, let me teach you this as well.

## **Congress failed to fulfill responsibility of the Opposition**

The Congress party is mostly responsible for the present condition of the Opposition. The Congress got a great opportunity to become a good opposition, and 10 years is not a short period. But they completely failed to fulfil that responsibility in those 10 years. There are also capable people in the Opposition (Congress party), but

when their (leaders) failed, they did not allow the competent people in their party to rise because it could then lead to complications. And that's why they did the same thing and repeatedly subdued those talented people in the opposition. There are many young and enthusiastic Members of Parliament in our House. They have enthusiasm and energy. But if they speak up, their image might rise, and perhaps someone else's image might get affected. With that concern in mind they did not allow the House to function to deny this young generation an opportunity to speak. In a way, they have inflicted such a big loss to themselves, the Opposition, the Parliament, and the country as well. And that's why I always believe that the country needs a healthy and effective Opposition. The country has suffered enough due to dynastic politics, and the Congress itself has paid the price for it. Now, even Adhir Babu is paying the price. We can see Adhir Babu's condition now. Otherwise, this was the time to stay in Parliament. But one has to serve the dynasty.

Now, look at the situation, our (Mallikarjun) Kharge ji has shifted from this House to another House, and Gulam Nabi (Azad) ji has even shifted from the party. All of this is the result of dynastic politics. In the pursuit of launching the same product repeatedly, the Congress shop is now facing the prospect of being closed. And we're not talking about this shop (Mohabbat Ki Dukan), you're saying it. You say you've opened a shop, you say it everywhere. Now, such a situation has developed that there is a need to put a lock on the shop. Here, our Dada (Adhir Ranja Chowdhury) cannot give up his habit; he is sitting there and commenting on dynastic politics. Let me explain a bit today. Pardon me, Mr Speaker Sir, I am taking a little more time today. What is the dynastic politics that we talk about? We have never opposed dynastic politics if more than one person progresses in the political field with public support in any family. We

talk about dynastic politics when a party is run by a family, which prioritizes party members from the family and when all decisions of the party are made by family members. That is dynastic politics. Neither Rajnath (Singh) ji nor Amit Shah ji have their own political parties. Therefore, where two parties of one family are mentioned, it is not appropriate in a democracy. In a democracy, it is not wrong if ten people from one family come into politics. We want young people to come. We also want this issue to be discussed. It's not just my concern; it's our concern for the democracy of the country, the politics of family dynasties and the politics of family parties. That's why if two people from one family progress, I welcome it; if ten people progress, I welcome it. The more new generations and good people come into the service of the nation, the better. The question is that families run parties. It's certain that if somebody is not the president then his or her son will be the president. This is a

danger to democracy. Thank you Dada (Adhir Ranjan Chowdhury)! Generally, I never speak about this topic, but I spoke about it today. Efforts are being made to repeatedly launch the same product.

The Congress has become entangled in one family, they can't see the aspirations and achievements of millions of families, they can't see, they are not prepared to see beyond their own family. And a 'cancel culture' has developed in the Congress, anything - cancel, anything - cancel. The Congress has become stuck in such a cancel culture. If we say Make in India, Congress says cancel it, if we say 'Aatmanirbhar Bharat (Self-reliant India), Congress says cancel it, if we say Vocal for Local, Congress says cancel it, if we say Vande Bharat Express, Congress says cancel it, if we talk about the new building of Parliament, Congress says cancel it. I am surprised. These are not Modi's achievements; these are the achievements of the country. How long will you nurture so much hatred? And because of that, you have also negated the successes of the country, the achievements of the country.

## Roadmap for 'Viksit Bharat'

The Hon'ble President discussed the economic aspects in detail while speaking about the roadmap for 'Viksit Bharat'. She discussed the foundational pillars of the economy intricately. Bharat's robust economy is being praised worldwide today; the entire world is impressed by it. And when the world is going through a crisis, naturally, she feels even better when Bharat is progressing. During the G20 Summit, all countries have seen what the world thinks about Bharat, what the world says about Bharat, and what the world does for Bharat. Based on the experiences of these ten years in office and seeing the strong economy of today's Bharat developing at a rapid pace, I confidently say that Bharat will become the world's third-largest economic power in our third term, and this is Modi's guarantee.

Were they not given the opportunity earlier? Everyone has been given a chance,

right!

When will we emerge as the world's third-largest economic power, some of our colleagues in the Opposition make a strange argument! They say, "What's the big deal? It will happen on its own. What's your contribution, what is the contribution of Modi? It will happen on its own." I want to explain through this House what the role of the government is, especially to the youth of the country. I want to tell the youth of the country how things happen and what is the role of the government.

Ten years ago, when the Interim Budget was presented in February 2014, you know who was ruling, and the country knows too. When the Finance Minister of that time presented the Interim Budget ten years ago, what he said at that time is of great significance. I am quoting him word by word. When you say that Bharat will automatically reach the third position, they should understand. What did they say? "I now wish to look forward and outline a vision for the future, vision for the future." The greatest economist of the universe was saying, "I now wish to look forward and outline a vision for the future." He further said, "I wonder how many have noted the fact that the economy of

the country in terms of size of its GDP is the 11th largest in the world." Imagine the pride when we reached 11th position in 2014. Today we have reached the 5th position, and what is happening to you now?

I am reading further. (Gaurav) Gogoi ji, thank you, you said it well. I am reading further, listen carefully, colleagues, listen carefully. He said, "It is the 11th largest in the world". It was a matter of great pride. Then he went on to say, "There are great things in the store. There is a well-argued view that in the next three decades, the nominal GDP will take the country to the 3rd rank after the US and China." At that time, this great economist of the universe was saying that we will reach the third position in thirty years, and then he said, "This is my vision." There are many people who live with these notions; he is the greatest economist of the universe. They were saying this in 2014, and what vision they see, that by 2044 Bharat will be the third-largest economy. This is their vision, this is their limit. They had lost the ability to dream; determination was a distant thing for them.

They offered the youth of my country to wait for thirty years. But today, we stand before you with confidence, standing in this august House. And I assure you that we will not take 30 years - this is Modi's guarantee. In my third term, the country will become the third-largest economic power in the world. I feel sorry for them for how they set goals and how far their thinking went. And you (the Congress leaders) were proud to be at 11th position, whereas, we have brought the economy of the country to fifth position. But if the country reaching the 11th position made you happy, then you should also be happy about the country reaching the fifth position. The country has reached 5th position, you should be happy. Where are you stuck?

The entire world is watching today the speed of the BJP government's work, the magnitude of our goals, and the strength of our resolve.

The saying goes, and this is often used in Uttar Pradesh: नौ दिन चले अढ़ाई कोस and I believe this saying perfectly defines the Congress party. The sluggish pace of the Congress has no comparison. The

speed at which work is being done in the country today is something a Congress government could never even imagine.

#### **4 crore houses built for rural poor**

For the rural poor, we have built 4 crore houses. And for the urban poor, 80 lakh pucca houses have been constructed. If these houses had been built at the pace of the Congress (government), I calculate what would have happened. If the pace of the Congress (government) had been as it was, it would have taken 100 years to accomplish this much work. Five generations would have passed.

In the last 10 years, electrification of 40,000 kilometers of railway tracks has been completed. If the country had been running at the pace of the Congress (government), it would have taken 80 years to

accomplish this task. In a way, four generations would have passed.

We have provided 17 crore additional gas connections and this is my account for 10 years. If we had followed the Congress (government's) pace, it would have taken another 60 years to provide these connections, which is equivalent to three generations spending their lives cooking over smoke.

During the term of our government, sanitation coverage has reached from 40 per cent to 100 per cent. If the Congress (government's) pace had been followed, this task would have taken another 60-70 years to accomplish, and at least three generations would have passed, but still there would be no guarantee whether it would have been achieved or not.

The mentality of the Congress has caused a lot of damage to the country. The Congress has never trusted the capabilities of the nation. They always considered themselves rulers and continuously underestimated the people, diminishing their importance.

#### **Congress always placed its trust solely in one family**

I know how they thought about the citizens of the country. They would feel a little pricked if I took his name. The first Prime Minister

of Bharat, Jawaharlal Nehru, made a statement from the Red Fort on August 15th, which I will now read: "The habit of working hard is not common in India. We do not work as much as the people of Europe, Japan, China, Russia, or America do." Nehru ji made these remarks from the Red Fort. "Do not think that these nations became prosperous by magic; it was through hard work and intelligence." He was giving certificates to them, undermining the people of Bharat. Nehru ji's perception of Indians was that they were lazy. Nehru ji's perception of Indians was that they were less intelligent.

Indira (Gandhi) ji's mindset wasn't much different from Nehru's. On August 15th, Indira ji said from the Red Fort, "Unfortunately, our habit is such that when a good deed is completed, we become complacent, and when difficulties arise, we become hopeless. Sometimes it feels like the entire nation has embraced a sense of defeatism." Looking at the Congress members today, it seems that while Indira ji may not have accurately assessed the (capabilities of the) people of the country, but she had made a precise assessment of the Congress party itself. The members of the Congress's royal family viewed my country's people in the same light because they themselves were like that. And even today, we see the same kind of thinking from them.

The Congress members have learned the new trade of motor mechanics, so they must have understood what alignment means. But what I see is that the alignment of the (I.N.D.I.A) alliance itself has gone awry. When they don't have trust in each other within their own alliance, how can they have faith in the country? We have faith in the capability of our nation, and we trust in the power of the people.



## Laid the foundation of 'New Bharat'

When the people of the country first gave us the opportunity to serve, we spent a considerable amount of time and energy during our first term, filling the potholes that existed during the time of the previous UPA government. We kept filling those potholes during our first term. In our second term, we laid the foundation of a new Bharat, and in our third term, we will accelerate the construction of 'Viksit Bharat'. In our first term, we advanced numerous public welfare initiatives such as Swachh Bharat, Ujjwala, Ayushman Bharat, Beti Bachao-Beti Padhao, Sugamya Bharat, Digital India... We transformed many pro-people projects into campaigns. We made the tax system

easier with decisions like GST. The public supported us wholeheartedly upon seeing these initiatives. They blessed us with even more support than before. Then, our second term began. The second term was about fulfilling promises and commitments. In our second term, we witnessed

the completion of achievements that the country had been waiting for a long time. We all saw the abrogation of Article 370. With the power of the votes of Hon'ble MPs, Article 370 was abolished. The Nari Shakti Vandan Adhiniyam, a law empowering women, was enacted in the second term.

From space to the Olympics, from powerful forces to Parliament, the echo of 'Nari Shakti' (women's power) is being heard. Today, the country has witnessed the empowerment of 'Nari Shakti'.

From north to south, east to west, people have witnessed decades-old and stalled projects being completed in a timely manner.

We have progressed from archaic laws under British rule, which were punitive in nature, to the modern justice system. Our government has abolished hundreds of such laws that had become irrelevant. More than 40,000 compliances have been eliminated by the government.

Bharat has envisioned the future progress through initiatives like "Amrit Bharat" and "Namo Bharat" trains.

The villages and the millions of people across the country have witnessed the 'Sankalp Yatra' of 'Viksit Bharat', and the effort put behind achieving saturation, ensuring that everyone receives what they rightfully deserve, and making efforts to reach out and provide at their doorstep is something the country is witnessing for the first time.

Lord Ram not only returned to his home but a great temple was constructed that will rejuvenate Bharat's great cultural heritage with new energy.

### **NDA will cross 400**

Now, the third term of our government is not too far away. There are about 100-125 days left. And this time, the Modi government, the entire country is saying, "This time, it's the Modi government," even Kharage ji is saying, "This time, it's the Modi government." But, I usually don't get caught up in numbers and statistics. But I can see the mood of the nation; it will ensure that the NDA (National Democratic Alliance) crosses the 400-mark. I said - I want to see the country prospering and reaching the pinnacle of success for the next thousand years. The third term will be dedicated to laying a strong foundation for the 1,000 years.

### **25 crore people moved out from multidimensional poverty**

I have great confidence for the people of Bharat and their future. I have immense faith in the capabilities of our 1.4 billion citizens. Over the past 10 years, 25 crore people have moved out from multidimensional poverty, which demonstrates this capability.

I have always said that if the poor are provided with tools, resources and dignity, our poor people have the capability to overcome poverty. We have chosen that path, and my poor brothers and sisters have demonstrated their ability to overcome poverty. With this mindset, we have provided them with tools, resources, dignity, and self-respect. Today, 50 crore poor people have bank accounts, something they could never have imagined before. About four crore poor families have a solid roof over their heads, which gives them a new sense of dignity. More than 11 crore families have access to clean drinking water through taps. These are the jobs that bring the most employment opportunities for our youth, creating the most job opportunities.

There has been an unprecedented leap in the tourism sector in the last 10 years. In our country, tourism is such a sector that

need to see how to control the prices of essential commodities." Who said this? It was said by Indira Gandhi ji. When she had locked all the doors in the country, people were put in jail in 1974; there was 30 per cent inflation, 30 per cent!

What she said in the speech will astonish you. She said, "If there is no land, meaning if there is no land for cultivation, then grow vegetables in your pots and containers." Such advice was given by people occupying high positions. There were two songs about inflation that became super hits at that time in our country. They were sung everywhere. One was 'Mehngai Mar Gayee' and the other was 'Mehngai Dayain Khaye Jaat Hai'. And both of these songs came during the Congress regime.

During the UPA's tenure, inflation was in double digits, this cannot be denied. And the UPA government's argument was ... insensitive! It was said that if you can afford to eat expensive ice cream, then why are you crying about inflation? This was said; whenever Congress

The country is shocked to see these stacks of currency notes. But now you cannot fool the people, the people are watching. There was

a talk of corruption worth 10-15 lakh crore rupees during the UPA government.

We have exposed scams worth lakhs of crores, and we have put all that money to work for the poor, for the welfare of the poor. Now, it has become very difficult for middlemen to loot the poor. I understand that you can have doubts about the allegations against them, but for those who have been proven guilty, who have served or are serving their sentences, you glorify them. What culture is this and what inspiration do you want to give to the future generations of this country? What kind of compulsion is leading you to do this? Those people are being glorified and touted as great people. Where the rule of the Constitution prevails, where there is democracy, such things cannot go on for long. These people should keep that in mind. Those who are glorifying such people are signing their own end with their own hands.

### **Fight against corruption will continue**

Investigation is the job of the agencies. Agencies are independent, and the Constitution has kept them independent. The job of judging is that of the judges, and they are doing their job. And Mr Speaker Sir, I want to reiterate in this august House once again, no matter how much oppression is inflicted upon me, the fight against corruption will continue. Those who have looted the country will have to return the money. I promise this to the nation from this august House. Make allegations against whosoever you want, but the country will not be allowed to be looted, and those who have looted will have to return what they have taken.

Some politicians may speak lightly of the armed forces, but I believe my country's armed forces

will not be demoralized. Those who dream of dividing the country, using language that aims to break the morale of our soldiers ... The country will never accept such attempts. What satisfaction do you find in breaking the country into pieces? You have already broken the nation into so many fragments, and yet you want to continue doing so. How long will you keep breaking it?

If there used to be discussions about Kashmir in this very House, there used to be concern, there would be accusations and counter-accusations. Today, there is talk of unprecedented development in Jammu and Kashmir, and it is being celebrated with pride. Tourism is continuously increasing. When there is a G20 summit held there, the entire world now praises it. Article 370 was kept alive, creating chaos. The way the people of Kashmir have embraced the abrogation of Article 370 ... who had created this problem? Who had thrust this problem to the nation? Who had created such a rift within the Indian Constitution?

wondering how he got the freedom to speak so much. I was thinking about this, but later I noticed that the two special 'commanders' weren't present that day. They are not present nowadays. And therefore, Hon'ble Kharge ji took great advantage of freedom. And I think Kharge ji must have heard a film song that day, 'Aisa Mauka Phir Kahan Milega' (where else will you get such an opportunity). Now that Kharge ji is no longer an umpire and a commando, so he was enjoying hitting boundaries and sixes. But one thing was very pleasing. I respectfully accept the blessing that he gave to the NDA for 400 seats. Now if you want to take the blessing back, you can, because we have returned (to power).

I vividly remember an incident from last year. We were sitting in that House (Lok Sabha) and there was a concerted effort to drown out the voice of the Prime Minister of the country. With great patience and humility, we listened to each and every one of your words. And even today, you have come prepared not to listen, but you cannot suppress my voice. The people of the country have empowered this

voice. The voice is emanating from the blessings of the people of the country, and that's why this time I have also come fully prepared just like last time. I thought that perhaps someone like you who came to the House will abide by the norms, but you meted out great injustice to me for an hour and a half or so. And despite that I did not transgress any boundaries during my reply.

I have also made a prayer. One can pray, and I keep praying. The challenge that has come to you from West Bengal (Chief Minister Mamata Banerjee) that the Congress won't be able to cross 40 (seats in this year's elections), I pray that you manage to save 40.

You (Kharge ji) said a lot about us and we heard. You have the right to speak in a democracy, and it is our responsibility to listen to you.

And whatever discussions that have taken place today, I should present them in front of the country, and therefore, I will make a genuine effort.

When I heard this, heard it there (Lok Sabha) and here (Rajya Sabha) too, my belief

has firmed up that the (Congress) party has become outdated not just in its thinking but in its functioning as well. And when the thought process becomes outdated, they (Congress members) have also outsourced their work. In no time, such a big party, a party that ruled the country for decades, is facing such a downfall, such a decline. We are not happy, we have sympathies towards you. But what will a doctor do, when the patient himself doesn't know (what he is suffering from). What more should I say?

It's true that today they (Congress members) talk a lot, but they have lost the patience to listen. However, I will definitely present my views in front of the country. The Congress party, which had openly strangled democracy in its greed for power, the Congress which had repeatedly dismissed democratically elected governments dozens of times overnight, the Congress which had (imprisoned several leaders behind bars) in complete disdain of democracy, the Congress which even tried to lock newspapers, has now developed a new hobby of building narratives to break the country. Not satisfied with that, now statements are being made to divide north-south? And

this Congress is giving us lectures on democracy and federalism?

### **Congress left no stone unturned in dividing the country**

The Congress party, which left no stone unturned in dividing the country in the name of caste and language, the Congress, which allowed terrorism and separatism to flourish for its own benefit, the Congress, which pushed the North-East into violence, separatism, and backwardness, the Congress party, which left the country facing a huge challenge of Naxalism during its rule, the Congress, which handed over large swathes of the country's land to enemies, the Congress, which prevented the modernization of the country's armed forces, is today lecturing us on national security and internal security? The Congress party, which has been confused since independence itself, spent its time in the same confusion whether industrialisation or farming is necessary, unable to decide whether to nationalize or privatize, remained confused. The Congress, which in its 10 years of rule brought the economy from 12th to 11th position, from 12th to 11th position in 10 years! And it doesn't take much effort to go from 12th to 11th as you progress. Through our efforts, we brought it to the 5th position in 10 years. And the Congress is giving us long lectures on economic policies here?"

Why did the country and the world perceive their 10-year tenure in such a way, why did the country become angry, why did so much anger develop in the country? Hon'ble Mr Chairman Sir, not everything has happened because of our words, the consequences of one's actions are now evident. They don't happen in another lifetime, they happen in this very life.

We do not speak ill of anyone, why should we? When people have said so much to them, what need is there for me to say anything to them? I want to present a kind of statement before the House. I am reading the first quote – Members know, this is a quotation. Members

know it. "Our growth has slowed down and fiscal deficit has increased, inflation has been rising continuously for the past 2 years. The current account deficit has exceeded our expectations." I have read this quote. This is not a quote from any BJP leader, neither

this quote is mine.

The then Prime Minister Shri Manmohan Singh ji during his 10-year tenure in the UPA government said this. He described this situation.

Now I read the second quote. "There is widespread anger in the country over the misuse of public office". How the institutions were misused then. I did not misuse the institutions at that time. This was said by the then Prime Minister Dr. Manmohan Singh ji. At that time, the whole country was protesting on the streets due to corruption, protests were going on in every corner. Now I will read the third quote - There are some lines of an amendment, listen to this too. "There is corruption in tax collection, and therefore, GST should be introduced. There is leakage in the ration scheme, which affects the poorest of the poor in the country the most. Measures need to be taken to stop this. There is doubt about the government contracts being given." This was also said by the then Prime Minister Respected Manmohan Singh ji. And before him, another Prime Minister (of the Congress

party) said that one rupee goes from Delhi, only 15 paise reaches (the beneficiaries). The problem was known to them, but there was no preparation to fix it. And today big statements are being made by them. Look at the 10-year history of the Congress. The country was called a Fragile Five Economy in the world then. It was not me, but the world was calling it Fragile Five. Policy paralysis had become their identity. And our 10 years will be remembered for being in the Top Five Economy. Our 10 years will be remembered for big and decisive decisions. We have worked very hard to bring the country out of crises. This country is not blessing us for nothing.

If you were not influenced by the British, then why couldn't you even build a War Memorial for the soldiers who sacrifice their lives for the country? Why was it not constructed? If you were not inspired by the British, why did you look down upon Indian languages? Why were you indifferent towards education in local languages?

If you were not inspired by the British, then who stopped you from calling Bharat the Mother of Democracy? Why didn't you realize? Hon'ble Mr Chairman Sir, I can provide hundreds of examples to show under whose influence you (the Congress) worked. And today the country is going to remember all these things after listening to it.

injustice towards our past has occurred. If you insult your beliefs, if you insult your good traditions, then you are considered progressive. Such narratives began to be built in the country. And the world knows well under whose leadership such narratives were spread. The glorification of importing from other countries and considering second class anything that was Indian... This status symbol was created. The products made in foreign countries were considered as a status symbol. These people still refrain from speaking up for Vocal for Local where the work for the welfare of the poor of my country happens. Today, they don't talk about 'Aatmanirbhar Bharat' (self-reliant India). When someone advocates for Make in India today, they get uncomfortable. The country has seen all this and now understands, and you are also suffering the consequences of that.

In her speech, the Hon'ble President addressed in detail about

four major categories: youth, women, the poor, and our farmers. We know that their issues are mostly similar, their dreams are also similar, and if we want to find solutions, there might be a slight difference, but the path to solutions for these four categories is the same. Therefore, she has aptly guided the nation to strengthen these four pillars so that the country will move forward to become 'Viksit Bharat' at a rapid pace.

### **Mindset of the 20th century cannot prevail**

If we are in the 21st century and want to fulfil the dreams of 'Viksit Bharat' by 2047 in this century, then the mindset of the 20th century cannot prevail. The selfish agenda of the 20th century, the game of "me and mine," cannot make Bharat prosperous and developed in the 21st century. These days, the Congress is discussing a lot about caste once again. I don't know why they felt the need for it. However, if they feel the need, they should first introspect and they will know what they have done. The Congress has always been the biggest opponent of Dalits, backward classes, and tribal communities. And sometimes I wonder if there would have been reservation for SC/ST if Babasaheb Ambedkar had not been there. This question also comes up in my mind.

I have evidence behind what I'm saying. Their mindset has not changed since then; I have evidence of that. I'm not here just to speak without evidence. And when such issues have been raised from there (the Congress), they should be prepared. And they have known me very well for the last 10 years. Of late, I remember (Jawaharlal) Nehru ji more often these days because our friends (in the Congress) expect me to speak about him (Nehru ji). Now, let me read out a letter written by Nehru ji. This letter was written by the country's Prime Minister Pandit Nehru to the chief ministers of the country at that time. It's on record. I'm reading the translation: "I do not like any kinds of reservations, especially reservations in jobs. I am against any step that promotes inefficiency and that



leads towards the second class." This is the letter written by Pandit Nehru ji to the chief ministers. And therefore, I say they are always opposed to reservations. Nehru ji used to say, if SC, ST and OBC communities get reservation in jobs, the standard of government work will deteriorate. And today, those who rattle the figures, the root of those is here. Because at that time, they stopped it (reservation), they said don't recruit. If their (SC, ST and OBC communities) recruitment had happened in the government at that time, and they had been promoted, they would have reached here today.

### **Congress deprived the rights of SC, ST, OBC in J&K**

I'm reading this quote, you can verify. I'm reading a quote by Pandit Nehru. You know, what Nehru ji said is always a milestone for the Congress. Nehru ji's saying means a milestone for them. You can pretend to say anything, but your thoughts are evident from

many examples. I can give you countless examples, but I want to give one example for sure, and I want to give the example of Jammu and Kashmir. The Congress kept the SC, ST, OBC communities of Jammu and Kashmir deprived of their rights for seven decades. Article 370 ... I am not talking about how many seats we will win now. Article 370 was abolished, and only then, after so many decades, did SC, ST, OBC communities get the rights that the people of the country had been getting for years. The Forest Rights Act was not available to them in Jammu and Kashmir. The Prevention of Atrocities Act was not there in Jammu and Kashmir; we gave them these rights by removing Article 370. Even in our SC community, if anyone was left behind, it was our Valmiki society. Even after seven decades, our Valmiki families in Jammu and Kashmir, who were serving the people, were not given the right to domicile. And today I also want to make the country aware that the Bill for OBC reservation in Local Self-Governments in local bodies was passed in the Lok Sabha yesterday, on February 6th.

The increasing participation of the SC, ST and OBC communities

has always been a major concern for the Congress and its allies. They left no stone unturned to eliminate Baba Saheb's politics and thoughts. The statements are available; what was said during the elections is also available. They weren't even prepared to give Bharat Ratna to him. He was awarded the Bharat Ratna only with the support of the BJP and when the (V.P.Singh) government was formed. Not only that, Sitaram Kesri, belonging to the extremely backward caste and who was the president of the Congress party, was thrown out on the footpath. (Because he was) OBC! The video is available; the country saw what happened with Sitaram Kesri.

One of their influential figures is sitting in America, who became famous for 'Hua to Hua' comment during the last elections. And the Congress is closely associated with this family. He has recently made significant efforts to diminish the contributions of the architect of the Constitution, Baba Saheb Ambedkar.

We have had the opportunity to work for 10 years in the NDA. We first made Dalit (Ram Nath Kovind) and now Adivasi (Droupadi Murmu) as President. We have always prioritized Dalits and Adivasis.

If you understand that society up close, who are the beneficiaries ultimately, who are these people? Who are these people living in slums, struggling for life? Which society do they belong to? They have to endure hardships, they have been deprived of facilities, which society is it? Whatever work we have done, it is for this society - the SCs, STs, OBCs, Adivasis. Providing proper homes to those living in slums has benefited my friends from this society. Previously, they struggled with diseases due to lack of cleanliness, now they have benefited from the Swachh Bharat Abhiyan under our initiatives, so that they can have a better life. Our mothers and sisters in these families were enduring health crises by cooking food over smoke, we gave them Ujjwala gas connections and they are from these

very families. Whether it is free ration, or free healthcare, the beneficiaries are these very families. All our schemes are meant for these family members from this section of society.

The narrative being presented here, denying facts in this manner, who will benefit from it? By doing so, you are not only losing your credibility but also your integrity.

Here, misleading statistics related to education have also been presented. What kind of effort is being made to mislead? Over the past 10 years, the scholarships provided to SC and ST students have increased. In these 10 years, the enrolment numbers in schools and higher education have also significantly increased, and the dropout rate has decreased rapidly.

Ten years ago, there were 120 Eklavya Model Schools. Today there are 400 Eklavya Model Schools. Why do you deny these facts? Why do you do this? I don't understand this.

Earlier, there was one Central Tribal University, today there are two Central Tribal Universities. It is also true that for a long time, Dalit, backward, and tribal sons and daughters could not even see the doors of colleges. I remember when I became the Chief Minister in Gujarat, I was presented with a surprising analysis. Umargam to Ambaji is an entire belt of tribal majority areas in Gujarat. Our Digvijay Singh's son-in-law is also from that area. In that entire area, there was not a single school offering science stream. When I went there, I thought if there is no school for my tribal children in that area offering the science stream, then where would the question of engineering or medical studies arise? Such basic necessities... and what speeches are being given here?

I want to inform the House and the members should take pride in it. You are sitting in the House, where a government is talking to you about such changes where there has been a significant transformation. Boost the confidence of that society, boost their morale. Let them progress rapidly into the mainstream of the country, let us strive for that, make collective efforts. Look at the enrolment of our tribal, SC, ST students;

Our effort is in that direction... Our effort is to solve the fundamental problems, even though it may take some time, but it should be done in a formidable manner. Therefore, we have put emphasis on education in this manner. If there is a lack of information, please let us know, we will provide you with the information. But do not create such narratives that diminish your dignity, weaken the power of your words. Sometimes, I feel

sorry for you.

### 'Sabka Saath, Sabka Vikas'!

'Sabka Saath, Sabka Vikas'! This is not just a slogan; it is Modi's guarantee. And when so much work is being done... Someone sent me a poem. The poem is quite long, but it contains a line:

denying the truth, will never be able to do any good to themselves or the country.

Every time the same song is sung. Statements are made without considering the facts just only to provoke certain sections of society. I want to present some realities before the country, and I believe the media should debate on such issues so that the truth can be revealed.

Here, various allegations were made against us regarding the government companies. What kinds of allegations are being made? There is no basis to such allegations. Now, let's remember the game

that was played with Maruti shares. It used to hog headlines during that time. What was happening with Maruti shares? I don't want to delve into the depths of it, or else they might drown in it and there might be a short circuit here. So, I don't want to delve deep into it. It is necessary for the country to know the truth!

I was born in independent Bharat. My thoughts are also independent, and my dreams are free too. Those who live with a slave mentality have nothing else but old papers to cling to.

The Congress said that we sold PSUs, we ruined PSUs, such kinds of discussions take place here, and I was hearing it from senior people. Remember who destroyed BSNL, MTNL? Which era was it when BSNL, MTNL were ruined? Recall the plight of HAL, how was it destroyed? And then they

set the agenda for the 2019 elections by giving speeches at HAL's gate. Those who destroyed HAL were giving speeches at HAL's gate. Who destroyed Air India? Who brought Air India to such a mess? The Congress party and the UPA cannot turn away

from its destruction. The country knows it well. Now, let me share some achievements from our tenure.

BSNL, which was struggling in the past due to you, has made significant progress in recent years. Today BSNL is moving towards Made in India 4G and 5G and is drawing the attention of the world.

acquire it; then they spread rumours that it's a haunted house. They create such an atmosphere that no one is willing to buy it. When no one shows interest, they eventually grab it. What was done with LIC? I want to say this with pride, with my head held high. Today, LIC shares are trading at record levels. Why is that?

are 254 PSUs now? What are you all doing?

Ten years ago, i.e., 2014. I am talking about the period between 2004 and 2014. The net profit of PSUs was approximately one and a quarter lakh crore rupees. And in these ten years, the net profit of PSUs has increased to two and a half lakh crore rupees. In the past decade, the net worth of PSUs has increased from 9.5 lakh crore rupees to 17 lakh crore rupees.

Wherever they intervene, it is destined to sink. They had created such a state of affairs. We have worked hard and brought the PSUs out of that situation. You should be happy, do not spread illusions and do not spread such rumours in the market that confuse the ordinary investors of the country. You cannot do such a thing.

Their limit is such that now they have turned their prince into a

start-up. Right now, he is a non-starter. He is neither taking off nor launching. If you (the Congress members) had stayed this calm last time as well, it would have been so much fun. Congratulations! Congratulations! Congratulations! Congratulations to everyone!

It has been my privilege to serve the country and the people as the Chief Minister of a state for a long time. Therefore, I understand regional aspirations very well because I emerged from that process myself. Leaders like Digvijay ji, who is sitting here, naturally understands what it means for a state because we come from the same world. We have the experience, we know. Sharad Pawar ji knows, and people like Deve Gowda Sahab understand all these things. So, we understand the importance of it. We don't have to read about it in books; we have experienced it firsthand. And this is also the truth for everyone. For about ten years, the entire machinery

of the UPA government was focused on doing something or the other for Gujarat. You can't imagine. But I don't shed tears; it's not my habit to cry. But even then, despite facing numerous crises, despite enduring all kinds of atrocities, my problem was such that I

couldn't even get an appointment with a minister here. Well, anyway, I can understand their difficulties now. Once, a major natural disaster struck in my state. I made so many requests to the Prime Minister to come and see it for himself. His schedule was arranged. There was an advisory committee then, maybe the order came from there that someone should conduct an aerial inspection by helicopter. I could understand that. Suddenly, he changed the program and went to some other state in the south. I don't remember which one today. I was told "We will see from the airplane, we will not come to Gujarat." I was in Surat, he was about to come. I know what must have happened in the end. So, you can imagine, I have faced such difficulties even during natural disasters. But despite that, my mantra



then and even today is that the development of the state is crucial for the development of the country. The development of Gujarat is essential for the development of Bharat. And we all should follow this path. We will only be able to achieve the nation's development through the development of states. There can be no dispute about this, no dispute at all. And I assure you, that if a state takes one step, I am ready to take two steps forward. What is cooperative federalism? And I have always advocated about Competitive Cooperative federalism. Today, the country needs Competitive Cooperative federalism. There should be healthy competition among our states so that our country can progress rapidly. We need to move forward with a positive mindset. And even when I was in the state, I worked with these same principles. That's why I silently endured.

COVID is an example. It was the world's biggest crisis. During such

Will we say that the vaccine was developed in that particular place, therefore it is their right, not the country's. Can we think like that? If the vaccine was developed in that city, will other parts of the country not benefit from it? Will we think like that? Is this the kind of thinking we are adopting? It is very unfortunate if such thoughts develop in a national party.

I want to ask, If the Himalayas were to start saying, "These rivers flow from here. I won't give you water. The right to water is mine," what would happen to the country? Where would the country go? If the states with coal were to say, "You won't get coal, this is our property, go spend your life in darkness," how would the country function?
