AYODHYA VERDICT

SUPREME COURT HAS GRANTED THE ENTIRE 2.77 ACRE OF DISPUTED LAND IN AYODHYA TO DEITY RAM LALLA.

THE FIVE-JUDGE SUPREME COURT BENCH LED BY CHIEF JUSTICE RANJAN **GOGOI HEARD THE LONG-PENDING** AYODHYA LAND DISPUTE FOR A PERIOD OF 40 DAYS AT A STRETCH AND PRONOUNCED THE UNINANIMOUS 5:0 JUDGMENT AND RULED IN FAVOUR OF THE RAM JANMABHOOMI.

IT SAID THAT THE FAITH OF THE HINDUS THAT LORD RAM WAS BORN AT THE DISPUTED SITE CANNOT BE DISPUTED.

THE SUPREME COURT SAID THE UNDERLYING STRUCTURE BELOW THE DISPUTED SITE AT AYODHYA WAS NOT **AN ISLAMIC STRUCTURE**

THE SUPREME COURT DISMISSED THE PLEA OF NIRMOHI AKHARA, WHICH **WAS SEEKING CONTROL OF THE ENTIRE** DISPUTED LAND, SAYING THEY ARE THE CUSTODIAN OF THE LAND.

IT HAS DIRECTED THE CENTRE AND **UTTAR PRADESH GOVERNMENT TO ALLOT AN ALTERNATIVE 5 ACRE LAND** TO THE MUSLIMS AT A PROMINENT PLACE OF AYODHYA TO BUILD A MOSQUE.




reputation of judiciary, established the efficacy of judicial process, shown to the world the power of the Indian constitution and further strengthened the democracy in India.

HISTORIC VERDICT OF SUPREME COURT ON S

COURT SAYS, "LORD RAM WAS BORN AT THE SITE V

VERDICT SHOULDN'T BE SEEN AS I

ettling a fractious issue that goes back to more than centuries, the highest Court of the country in a historic verdict on 09 November, 2019 backed the construction of a Shri Ram temple by a trust at the disputed site in Ayodhya, and ruled that an alternative five-acre plot must be provided by the Central government for a mosque in the limits of the holy town of Ayodhya.

Delivering a unanimous judgement on a case that has long polarized the country, a five-judge bench of the apex court headed by Chief Justice of India Ranjan Gogoi said, 'The faith of Hindus that Lord Ram was born at the site was undisputed, and he is symbolically the owner of the land'.


The judgement treated the case as a title dispute over land between three parties -- the Sunni Muslim Waqf Board, the Nirmohi Akhara, a Hindu group, and the symbolic Lord Rama designated as Ram Lalla Virajman.

"The dispute is over immovable property. The court does not decide title on the basis of faith or belief but on the basis of evidence," the judgement, delivered at the end of a marathon 40-day hearing-the second longest in the history of apex court said.

The apex court bench headed by Chief Justice of India Ranjan Gogoi and comprised justices SA Bobde, Ashok Bhushan, DY Chandrachud and S Abdul Nazeer unanimously concluded that, "The faith of the Hindus that Lord Ram was born at the demolished structure is undisputed".

The verdict in the Ram Janmbhoomi-Babri Masjid land dispute case, one of the most significant judgements in India's history, runs into 1,045 pages.

The judgement was widely welcomed by all sections of people, politicians, Hindu & Muslim religious groups and leaders. All political and religious leaders called for peace and calm, and leaders across the political spectrum noted that it was now

court seeking permission to build a canopy outside the mosque for daily puja. The plea was dismissed.

In December 1949, Sant Digvijay Nath of Gorakhnath Math joined the Akhil Bharatiya Ramayana Mahasabha and organised a 9-day continuous recitation of the Ramcharit Manas, at the end of which Hindu activists placed the idols of Lord Ram and Sita inside the central dome of the mosque. The structure was destroyed by uncontrolled large gathering of kar Sevaks on December 6, 1992.

The court judgement said "The Constitution must ensure that a wrong committed must be remedied". As part of remedy for that wrong, the court asked the government to allot a five-acre plot in a prominent location in the holy town of Ayodhya in Uttar Pradesh for constructing a new mosque.

The disputed 2.77-acre plot will for now remain with a Central government receiver, who will hand it over to a government-created trust that must be created within three months. The trust will be tasked with the construction of the temple.

The judgement said, "On the balance of probabilities, there is clear evidence to indicate that the worship by the Hindus in the outer courtyard" has continued unimpeded even before 1857 when the British annexed Oudh region. "The Muslims have offered no evidence to indicate that they were in exclusive possession" of the mosque before 1857,

Commenting on the historic judgment former Deputy Prime Minister Shri Lal Krishna Advani stated:


"I join all my countrymen in wholeheartedly welcoming the historic judgement delivered by the five-member Constitution Bench of the Supreme Court in the Ayodhya matter.

I stand vindicated, and feel deeply blessed, that the Supreme Court has given its unanimous verdict paving the way for the construction of a magnificent temple for Lord Ram at Ramjanmabhoomi in Ayodhya.

This is a moment of fulfilment for me because God Almighty had given me an opportunity to make my own humble contribution to the mass movement, the biggest since India's Freedom Movement, aimed at the outcome which the Supreme Court's verdict today has made possible.

I have always stressed that Ram and Ramayana occupy an esteemed place in India's cultural and civilizational heritage and Ramjanmabhoomi holds a special and sacred place in the hearts of crores of our countrymen in India and abroad. Today's judgement is the culmination of a long and contentious process that played itself out in various forums – both judicial and non-judicial – in the past many decades. Now that the prolonged Mandir-Masjid dispute in Ayodhya has come to an end, the time has come to leave all contention and acrimony behind and embrace communal concord and peace. Towards this end, I appeal to all sections of our diverse society to work together to strengthen India's national unity and integrity.

In the course of the Ramjanmabhoomi Movement, I had often stated that the true purpose of constructing a Ram Mandir at Ayodhya is to construct a magnificent Rashtra Mandir – building India as a strong, prosperous, peaceful and harmonious nation with justice for all and exclusion of none. Let us rededicate ourselves to that noble mission today."

it said.

The verdict was pronounced on 14 appeals filed in the apex court against the 2010 Allahabad High Court judgment, delivered in four civil suits, that the 2.77-acre land in Ayodhya be partitioned equally among the three parties -- the Sunni Waqf Board, the Nirmohi Akhara and 'Ram Lalla'.

The bench said the high court wrongly decided the title suit by resorting to partitioning of the disputed land in three parts. "The disputed site was government land in the revenue records," the court said adding," The fact that there is a temple beneath the destroyed structure has been established by the Archaeological Survey of India(ASI) and the underlying structure was

not an Islamic structure."

A five-judge bench headed by Chief Justice of India (CJI) Ranjan Gogoi finished the hearing in the long-standing dispute on October 16 and said he would deliver the verdict before he retires on November 17. On November 8, it was announced that the verdict will be delivered a day later at 10:30 AM.

RSS Sarsanghchalak Shri Mohan Bhagwat, said the building of a Ram temple is a long-held objective but the verdict should not be seen as anybody's victory or defeat.

C S Vaidyanathan, lawyer for deity 'Ram Lalla', said the verdict is very balanced and it is a victory of people. The Nirmohi Akhara said it has no "regrets"



SC REFERRED TO BOOKS, TRAVELOGUES, ARCHAEOLOGICAL REPORTS, PHOTOS, INSCRIPTIONS ON PILLARS IN AYODHYA VERDICT

The Supreme Court referred to books on subjects as diverse as history, culture, archaeology and religion in languages as varied as Sanskrit, Hindi, Urdu, Persian, Turkish, French and English in its judgment on the Ayodhya land dispute.

The apex court bench, headed by Chief Justice Ranjan Gogoi perused 533 documentary exhibits, including religious texts, travelogues, archaeological excavation reports, photographs of the site prior to demolition of the mosque and details of artifacts found at the disputed site.

The exhibits also included gazetteers and translations of inscriptions on pillars. On January 10, 2019, the top court had directed its Registry to inspect the records and if required, engage official translators.

On February 7, 2002, counsel for the petitioners in suit number five filed a report before the Allahabad High

Court pertaining to the Ayodhya Vishnu Hari temple inscription and under the court's orders, an e-stampage was prepared and was deciphered by an epigraphist, the apex court said.

It also referred to translated versions of Ain-i-Akbari, which was completed in the 16th century during Mughal emperor Akbar's regime.

"The Ain-i-Akbari was work of Abul-Fazl Allami, who was one of the ministers in Akbar's court. The Aini-Akbari was translated by H Blochmann from Persian to English. By its order dated March 18, 2010, the high court permitted the text to be relied on...," the bench said.

It said travelogues of Father Joseph Tieffenthaler, which were translated from Latin to French and then its English translations were filed before the high court, were extensively relied on by counsels arguing in the title dispute.

MUDRA YOJANA BENEFICIARIES CREATE 11 MN JOBS

oans availed through the Pradhan Mantri Mudra Yojana (PMMY), also known as Mudra loans, led to a 28 per cent rise in jobs generated by establishments which had taken benefit of the scheme, according to an official survey conducted by the government.

The report on PM Mudra Yojana, prepared by the Labour Bureau under the Ministry of Labour and Employment, showed that around 39.3 million people were employed in establishments prior to availing Mudra loans, which increased to 50.4 million after these took benefit of the scheme.

The PMMY was launched in April 2015 to give unsecured loans of up to Rs 10 lakh, with the objective of boosting self-employment. As a result, a total of 11.2 million new jobs, 55 per cent of which accounted for self-employment, were created through Mudra loans between 2015 and 2018, the survey report showed.



Significantly, 89 per cent of beneficiaries found Mudra loans to be sufficient for expanding their business or setting up a new unit and the remaining 11 per cent had to avail loans from other sources, as per the survey report.

UPI hits 1 billion transactions in October, plans to go global

ccording to times news network, Transactions using India's own domestic payments platform—Unified Payments Interface (UPI)—hit a landmark of one billion in October,three years after its launch. The UPI also recently crossed 100 million users, making it the fastest adoption of any payments system anywhere in the world.

Having achieved this double milestone, the National Payments Corporation of India (NPCI), which operates the UPI platform, aims to take the network global by enabling acceptance of UPI in Singapore and the UAE.

The UPI platform, which was launched before demonetisation in 2016, enables users to send money

from their account to any account without entering bank details by using an email-like handle or scanning a QR code. The NPCI, which launched the RuPay network, had launched this to promote digital payments by harnessing the ubiquitousness of smartphones.

"The UPI has had the fastest acceptance not just in payments but among other platforms as well. I have not compared the numbers but given the time taken to reach 100 million users by social media and other platforms. I am sure we should be among the top," said Dilip Asbe, chief executive officer, NPCI. To put things in perspective, in August the total volume of all card transactions (debit and credit) put together was 142 crore (1.42 billion).

'India registers 26.9 per cent decline in Maternal Mortality Rate since 2013'

ndia has registered a 26.9 per cent reduction in Maternal Mortality Ratio (MMR) since 2013. The decline in MMR has been from 77 to 72 per 100,000 live births among southern states and in the other states, from 93 to 90 according to the Sample Registration System released on 07 Novemebr, 2019.

The ratio has declined from 167 in 2011-2013 to 130 in 2014-2016 and to 122 in 2015-17, registering a 6.15 per cent reduction since the last survey figures of 2014-2016, according to the special bulletin of the Office of the Registrar General. "It is heartening that the maternal mortality ratio has declined from 130 in 2014-2016 to 122 in 2015-17. The decline has been most significant in empowered action group (EAG) states and Assam from 188 to 175," it said.

To understand the maternal mortality situation in the country better and to map the changes that have taken place, especially at the regional level, the government has categorized states into three groups - EAG, southern states and "other" states.

Kerala, Maharashtra and Tamil Nadu have already met the sustainable development goals target of 70 per 100,000 MMR, while Andhra Pradesh and Telangana are within "striking distance", a senior



health ministry official said.

EAG states comprise Bihar, Jharkhand, Madhya Pradesh, Chhattisgarh, Odisha, Rajasthan, Uttar Pradesh and Uttarakhand, and Assam. The southern states are Andhra Pradesh, Telangana, Karnataka, Kerala and Tamil Nadu and the "other" states categories cover the remaining states and Union territories.

The WHO last year also lauded India's progress in reducing the MMR saying the progress puts the country on track towards achieving the Sustainable Development Goal (SDG) target of an MMR below 70 by 2030.

Forex reserves soar to new lifetime high of \$446.09 billion

he country's foreign exchange reserves rose by USD 3.515 billion to touch a fresh lifetime high of USD 446.098 billion in the week to November 1, helped by increase in foreign currency assets, RBI data showed on 08 November, 2019. In the previous week, the reserves had increased by USD 1.832 billion to USD 442.583 billion.

The increase in reserves in the reporting week was mainly on account of a jump in foreign currency assets (FCA), a major component of the overall reserves.

FCA increased by USD 3.201 billion to USD 413.654 billion in the week ended November 1, the RBI said.

Expressed in US dollar terms, the foreign currency assets include the effect of appreciation or depreciation of non-US units like the euro, pound and the yen held in the foreign exchange reserves.

During the week, gold reserves increased by USD 301 million to USD 27.353 billion. The special drawing rights with the International Monetary Fund increased by USD 2 million to USD 1.443 billion during the week.

The country's reserve position with the Fund also increased by USD 10 million to USD 3.648 billion, the data showed.

Govt sanctions Rs. 25,000 crore fund to revive 1,600 projects with 4.6 lakh housing units

he government on 06 November, 2019 cleared a fund with an initial corpus of Rs 25,000 crore to revive up to 4.6 lakh housing units in 1,600 projects with "positive net worth", including those that have been classified by banks as non-performing assets or are facing insolvency resolution action.

While announcing the move, which was approved by the Union Cabinet, finance minister Smt. Nirmala Sitharaman indicated there may be some relief for those who have defaulted on repayment of their home loan EMIs in the stalled projects across the country.

MONEY WON'T BE USED TO CLEAR PAST DUES: SITHARAMAN

The latest package comes two months after the government had announced the establishment of a Rs 20,000-crore fund for the completion of stalled affordable and middle-income housing projects but had kept NPA and NCLT cases out of the ambit of the "special window" for the real estate sector, which is facing an acute downturn due to a liquidity crunch as several builders are highly leveraged and are unable

to sell new apartments.

Smt. Sitharaman said that based on feedback from homebuyers and other stakeholders, the government decided to expand the ambit of the fund, where the Centre will chip in with Rs 10,000 crore and entities such as the State Bank of India, LIC and other institutions, including overseas funds, will contribute Rs 15,000 crore.

The fund will provide loans on commercial terms after assessing the viability of each project but will ensure that the money flows into an escrow account so that it is used only for construction purposes. Smt. Sitharaman said the money will not be used to clear past dues, which will be dealt with separately.

The plan is to take up only financially viable projects with the FM ruling out providing any sort of "grants", although the overall idea is to revive as many housing projects as possible to help middle-class homebuyers who have invested their savings in buying houses. Many buyers are paying EMIs while staying on rent as the projects are indefinitely delayed and in many cases the builders are behind bars.

Pradhan Mantri Jan Suraksha Yojana enrollments see pickup; 14.7 million enrollments in H1

fter seeing a stagnation in enrollments, Pradhan Mantri Jan Suraksha Yojana insurance schemes have got 15 million new enrollments in H1 of the year. This was driven by a government nudge to the banks as well as zero premium increase.

According to a report published in Moneycontrol.com, the insurance scheme saw some stagnation in



FY18 and FY19 but enrollments picked up again from April 2019 onwards.

The personal accident scheme (Pradhan Mantri Suraksha Bima Yojana/PMSBY) and term insurance scheme (Pradhan Mantri Jeevan Jyoti Bima Yojana/PMJJBY) were launched in May 2015.

Both policies have a sum assured of Rs 2 lakh each and need to be renewed after one year. But their premiums are low at Rs 12 and Rs 330, respectively.

DHARMA IS NOT RELIGION

HE distortions of Dharma that we now-a-days see all around us are largely the result of foreign education. The English word 'religion' has substantially contributed distorting the pure meaning of Dharma. The British first heard the word when they came to India. They had no word of an equally comprehensive meaning. So they translated it as religion. Such translation has distorted the meaning of Indian words. Dharma is a very wide term which includes many religions. A religion a system of worship, and there are many such systems prevailing in this land. But in spite of these systems and sects Dharma is one. Dharma is that which is good for everyone irrespective of the system of worship and can open up for him the way to salvation.

DHARMA SUSTAINS WORLD

RELIGION means a creed, or a sect, it does not mean Dharma. Dharma is a very broad concept. It is concerned with all aspects of life. It sustains society. It sustains the whole world. That which sustains is "Dharma"

The fundamental principles of Dharma are eternal and universal.

Yet their implementation may differ according to time, place and circumstance.

The complete treatise on the rules in general and their philosophical basis is the meaning of Dharma.

These rules cannot be arbitrary. They should be such as to sustain and further the existence and progress of the entity which they serve.

FUNDAMENTAL OF CIVILISED LIFE

WE believe in Dharma not just because it is instrumental in acquiring Artha but because it is a fundamental principle of civilized life.

Kama too can be attained only through Dharma. Having produced the material things, such as nice food, when, where, how and in what measure it will be used can be determined only by Dharma. If a sick person eats food meant for a healthy one and vice versa, both of them will be at a disadvantage. Dharma helps in restraining the natural tendencies of man whereby he is able to determine what is beneficial to him apart from what is pleasurable. Hence Dharma is given the fore- most place in our culture.

DHARMA GUIDES GOD

GOD cannot act contrary to Dharma. If he does, then he is not omnipotent. Adharma is a characteristic of weakness, not of strength. If fire; instead of radiating heat, dies out,

it ist no longer strong. Strength les not in unrestrained behaviour, but in well-regulated action. Therefore God who is omnipotent is also selfregulated and consequently fully in tune with Dharma. God descends in the human body to destroy adharma and re-establish Dharma, not to act on passing whims and fancies. Hence even God can do everything but act contrary to Dharma. But for the risk of being misunderstood, one can say that Dharma is even greater than God. The universe is sustained because He act: according to Dharma.

DHARMA IS HIGHER

NEITHER the Legislature is higher nor the Judiciary. Dharma is higher than both. The Legislature will have to act according to Dharma. Dharma will specify the limits of both. The Legislature, the Judiciary or the people, none of these is supreme. Some will say, "Why, people are sovereign. They elect". But even the people are not sovereign because people too have no right to act against Dharma. If an elected government allows people to go against Dharma and does not punish, then that government is in reality a government of thieves. Even the general will cannot go against Dharma. Imagine the situation, if by some manoeuvring, thieves gain a majority in the government and send one of their ranks as an executive. What will be the duty of the minority if the majority is of thieves and elects a thief to rule?

DHARMA RAJYA

IN our country we cannot think of any sentiment with which Dharma is not bound up. Hence we feel that our State cannot forsake Dharma. A secular State, in our opinion. does not mean a State without Dharma. The word Religion means a tenet in this country and those who believe it are called sects like the Jains. Shaivas and Christians. Naturally the State cannot belong to any of these sects. It must look on all with an equal eye. So we can say that a State is non-sectarian. This would be the ideal, but such a State, even without being partial

to a particular sect or against some other sect, can encourage ways and means of achieving both material and spiritual progress and thus be called Dharma Rajya.

JANA RAJYA AND DHARMA RAJYA

IF the four million people of Kashmir say that they want to secede, if the

people of Goa say they want to secede and if some say they want the Portuguese to return, all this will be against Dharma. Of the 45 crore people of India, even if 449,999,999 opt for something which is against Dharma, even then this does not become truth. On the other hand. even if one person stands for something which is in accord with Dharma, that constitutes truth. because truth resides with Dharma. It is the duty of this one person that he tread the path of truth and change people. It is from this basis that a person derives the right to proceed according to Dharma.

Let us understand very clearly that Dharma is not necessarily with the majority or with the people. Dharma is eternal. Therefore, in the definition of democracy, to say that it is a government of the people is not enough; it has to be for the good of the people. Dharma alone can decide.. Therefore, a democratic government "Jana Rajva", must also be rooted in Dharma i.e. a "Dharma Rajya". In the definition of 'Democracy' viz. "government of the people, by the people and for the people", 'of stands for independence, 'by' stands for democracy, and 'for'

indicates Dharma. Therefore the true democracy is one where there is freedom as well as Dharma.

WRONG MEANING OF SPIRITUALISM

ONE of the main reasons for looking to the West for a solution to economic problems is the mistaken belief that indian culture and religion, being spiritual, are indifferent towards problems of a material life. This erroneous belief is the result of deliberate propaganda and of a wrong meaning of spiritualism. As a matter of fact our definition of religion ('Dharma') has taken materialism fully into

account. Dharma is defined as that which leads to both physical and metaphysical development. Materialism and spiritualism are neither contradictory nor separate from each other. Spiritualism is a point of view of life from which we look at all problems. If spiritualism can give a true definition of the universe there is no reason why it should not give us a solution to all problems of the world. India has not thought only of the metaphysical world, it has thought of material wealth also. Chanakya has said that happiness depends upon Dharma and Dharma depends upon material wealth.

DYNAMIC RELIGION

THF Vedic Reliaion has always underdone transformation. This dynamic reliaion and living. It is not like a stagnant pool. New thoughts have always entered this religion and old thoughts have developed through

change, but every new change has kept up its link with the old. Every new agitator maintained a feeling of reverence for his ancestors. Every new reformer gave respect to our ancient tradition, our ancestors and achievements and at the same time propounded new thoughts to suit the times. As these new thoughts had not broken off with the basic thought, they did not in any way harm the life of the nation. On the contrary, they contributed to its development.

'RAJNITI KE AJATSHATRU'- KAILASHPATI MISHRA

Kailashpati (05 October, 1923 - 03 November, 2012) was a great social servant and political leader. He was leader of the BJP and a former Governor of Gujarat and Rajasthan. He was born in Dudharchak, Buxar, Bihar on 05 October, 1923. He was a bachelor and popularly called the "Bhishmapitamah" of Bihar BJP. In the political circle people also called Shri Kailashpati Mishra as 'Rajniti ke Ajatshatru'. Shri Kailashji always maintained a cordial relation even with the leaders of other parties.

He was affiliated with the Rashtriya Swayamsevak Sangh (RSS) from 1944 onwards, and was even jailed after the assassination of Mahatma Gandhi. He took part



in the Quit India Movement in 1942 and was arrested for the same and was associated with the Rashtriya Swayamsevak Sangh from 1943. He won the Assembly election for Bikram. Patna. and was Finance Minister in Bihar Government led by Janata Party. Shri Mishra was appointed Bihar's Finance Minister in 1977-78 when the Janata Party

government was in power.

Shri Kailashpati Mishra died on 03 November, 2012 at the age of 89, in Patna, Bihar,

- Shri Mishra had served as finance minister in the government of Karpoori Thakur in Bihar in 1977. In 1980. he became the first Bihar BJP President.

n his opening remarks, Prime Minister expressed happiness in being part of the 16th India - ASEAN Summit held in Bangkok on November 03, 2019. He thanked Thailand for the warm hospitality and extended best wishes to Vietnam for taking over as Chairman of next year's Summit.

Prime Minister said that India's Act East Policy is a significant cornerstone of the Indo-Pacific strategy; adding that ASEAN is at the core of Act East Policy. A strong ASEAN will immensely benefit India. Prime Minister highlighted steps being taken to improve surface, maritime, air and digital connectivity. One billion dollar Indian line of credit will prove beneficial for improving physical and digital connectivity, he said. Prime Minister highlighted that last year's Commemorative Summit and Singapore Informal Summit's Decisions implementation has brought India and ASEAN closer. India is willing to increase cooperation and partnership in areas mutually beneficial to India and ASEAN and expressed readiness to improve partnership and capacity building in the areas of agriculture, research, engineering, science and ICT. Prime Minister said that India wants to strengthen cooperation in the areas of maritime security and blue economy. He also welcomed the recent decision to review India ASEAN FTA saying it will improve economic partnership between the two countries.

EAST ASIA SUMMIT

He also participated in the 14th East Asia Summit as well as the third RCEP Summit. This is the sixth time that Prime Minister Narendra Modi participated in the East Asia Summit. and at this summit the leaders reviewed the future direction of EAS and also exchanged views on regional and international issues such as Indo-Pacific, terrorism, violent extremism and transnational crimes. They also discussed South China Sea, the situation in the Korean Peninsula as well as in the Rakhine State in Myanmar.

BILATERAL ENGAGEMENT

Prime Minister Shri Narendra Modi held bilateral meetings on the sideline of ASEAN summit. First he held bilateral meeting with the Prime Minister of Japan, in that the two leaders reviewed the progress on Mumbai Ahmedabad High Speed Rail project and welcome to the inaugural 2+2 Foreign and Defence Ministerial Dialogue which will focus on bilateral security and defense cooperation. The two leaders also agreed to strengthen bilateral cooperation including in third countries for peace, progress and prosperity of the Indo-Pacific region. Our prime minister looked forward to Prime Minister Abe's visit to India for the India Japan Annual Summit in December 2019.

The second bilateral which Prime Minister had was with the prime minister of Vietnam who will now take over the chair of ASEAN and so he said that we would fully support Vietnam as it is the chair of ASEAN next year in its work.

The third bilateral Prime Minister had was the Prime Minister of Australia and they also reviewed the entire bilateral relationship. Prime Minister Scott Morrison accepted the invitation of Prime Minister to visit India and he would, during his visit, be the keynote speaker at the Raisina Dialogue in January 2020.

IN NATIONAL INTEREST INDIA OPTS OUT OF RCEP AGREEMENT

Prime Minister's last engagement was his participation in the third RCEP Summit. India conveyed its decision at the summit not to join the RCEP agreement. This reflects both assessment of the current global situation as well as of the fairness and balance of the agreement. India had significant issues of core interest that remained unresolved. In his remarks on the subject Prime Minister highlighted that he was guided by the impact it would have on the lives and livelihoods of all Indians especially vulnerable sections of society. He spoke of Mahatma Gandhiji's advice on recalling the face of the weakest and the poorest and then ask if the steps are of any use to them.

INDIA AND GERMANY SIGN 17 MOUS

t the invitation of Prime Minister Shri Narendra Modi, German Federal Chancellor Dr. Angela Merkel visited India from 31 October - 1 November 2019 for the fifth round of Inter-Governmental Consultations (IGC). Chancellor Merkel was accompanied by Ministers of Foreign Affairs, Science and Education, Food and Agriculture, and an Official Delegation. A business delegation comprising leaders of German companies also accompanied Chancellor Merkel. During the visit, Chancellor Merkel held meetings with President Ram Nath Kovind and Prime Minister Modi.

Chancellor Merkel and Prime Minister Shri Modi reiterated that the Indo-German Strategic Partnership is based on the common values and principles of democracy, free and fair trade, and rules-based international order, as well as on mutual trust and respect. Key issues in the discussions included jointly driving the digital transformation through innovation and frontier technologies, especially artificial intelligence, making economic growth sustainable by cooperating on climate change, creating space for people to people contacts through legal mobility for skilled labour, and contributing to a reliable international order by strengthening and updating multilateral institutions.

delegation 27 European MPs visited Srinagar on October 29 to assess the ground situation in Kashmir after the government gave permission for the "unofficial" visit. According to report published in 'India Today' The EU parliamentary delegation, comprising of MPs from UK, Poland, France and other countries interacted with local representatives in Kashmir valley to get a first-hand understanding of the situation over there. This is the first foreign delegation that has visited Kashmir after the government scrapped Article 370 in August. Speaking to the delegation earlier, NSA Ajit Doval said there normalcy has returned to most parts of the Valley and rejected Pakistan's narrative on Kashmir.

Newton Dunn, a lawmaker from the UK sharing the experience of the visit said, "We belong to a place Europe which is peaceful after years of fighting. And we want to see India becoming the most peaceful country in the world. And for that we need to stand by India in its fight against global terrorism. This visit has been an eye opener and we would definitely advocate what we have seen on ground zero."

"We are Indian citizens and we want to be Indian like all other Indian citizens... we want to have development like other parts of country, locals told us," another lawmaker said. After a traditional Kashmiri welcome, the leaders were briefed by Jammu and Kashmir Chief Secretary BVR Subrahmanyam and police chief Dilbag Singh. The team also interacted with some newlyelected panchayat members and councillors.

MEMBERS OF EUROPEAN PARLIAMENT CALLED ON PM MODI

Prime Minister said that India's relationship with the European Union is based on shared interests and common commitment to democratic values. He said that an early conclusion of a fair and balanced BTIA is a priority for the government. Talking about the need to strengthen engagement with EU on regional and global matters, Prime Minister highlighted the importance of close international cooperation to fight terrorism. He also mentioned about the growth of International Solar Alliance as a global partnership.

Prime Minister, while welcoming the delegation to India, expressed the hope that they have a fruitful visit to various parts of the country, including to Jammu and Kashmir. Their visit to Jammu and Kashmir should give the delegation a better understanding of the cultural and religious diversity of the region of Jammu, Kashmir and Ladakh; apart from giving them a clear view of the development and governance priorities of the region.

India signs agreement with Saudi Arabia to launch RuPay card

t the invitation of the Custodian of the Two Holy Mosques King Salman bin Abdulaziz Al Saud, the Prime Minister Shri Narendra Modi paid an official visit to the Kingdom of Saudi Arabia on 29 October 2019. The two sides held bilateral talks during which they reviewed the historical and close relations that bind the two friendly countries and their peoples. They exchanged views on regional and international issues of mutual interest. They underlined the relations of friendship and partnership embodied in economic, social, cultural and civilizational ties between the people of the two countries, and the great common opportunities that provide a strong momentum for the development of relations between the two friendly countries.

During the visit India also signed the agreement with Saudi Arabia to launch the RuPay card in the country, making it the third nation in the West Asia to initiate India's digital payment system which will benefit not only the 2.6 million Indians in the Gulf Kingdom but also Haj and Umrah pilgrims.

The RuPay card is a first-of-its-kind Indian domestic



Debit and Credit Card payment network, with acceptance at ATMs, POS devices and e-commerce websites. It was launched in 2012 to fulfil the Reserve Bank of India's vision to have a domestic, open and multilateral system of payments.

BJP GETS NEW OFFICE IN LEH AT HEIGHT OF OVER 11.000 FT

ai Singh Road in central Delhi, near Bangla Sahib Gurdwara, is the new address of the Delhi Police headquarters. Its newly constructed 17-floor building was inaugurated by Union Home Minister Shri Amit Shah on the occasion of the birth anniversary of Sardar Vallabhai Patel, the country's first home minister on 312 October, 2019.

Constructed at a cost of Rs. 286 crore and spread over 8.092 acres, the complex is the first headquarters that officially belongs to the Delhi Police — till a day
